# CALL TO ORDER

Board chair Birt Johnson, Jr., called the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation for Monterey County to order at 3:32 PM, Tuesday, August 25, 2020.

#### Motion: to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Loren Steck / Ida Lopez Chan second. Motion carried unanimously.

# **REPORT OF THE CHAIR – Birt Johnson, Jr.**

Birt reflected on the central themes of the recent annual reports, *Engaging for Good* and "grantmaking creates impact, impact creates resources and resources fuel granting." These values are strategically focused in current CFMC responses to the 2020 disasters. Birt praised the CFMC board, CEO and staff for their evolution in the community leadership role, building trust a dependable source for donations, resources and action during disasters and uncertain times.

December 15 was confirmed for the last board meeting of the year.

# CEO update for Monterey County Fires – Dan Baldwin

CFMC started the Monterey County Fire Relief Fund days after the River, Carmel and Dolan Fires began. It is a general fund to cover the three fires burning throughout the county. Donor's can designate funds to a specific fire. The fund currently has \$233,000, with over \$40,000 in grants distributed to organizations working in congregate shelters and directly with people caught without any resources. There is uncertainty as to what the scale of resources needed will be. There are three levels to this emergency-relief, recover, rebuild-so the funds will continue to be distributed over time.

Dan discussed how the money in the discretionary funds are for general grantmaking in the Fall of 2020. The CFMC reallocated \$250,000 from the discretionary grantmaking pool to the Covid-19 Relief Fund in March. Dan proposed how to support the fires and Covid-19 emergencies going forward without further impacting the Fall grant cycle.

After researching alternative funding sources for the fire emergencies within CFMC, Dan recommended to the finance committee that within the general operating finances are the Board Designated Operating Reserve funds of \$500,000. He recommends a loan of up to \$150,000 be available to the MC Fire Relief Fund, if needed. There is also a dormant Trustee Fund of \$6400 and \$5000 in the Pass-through fund which are useable as well. These funds could be replenished as donations are brought in.

# Motion: to approve the recommendation by the Finance Committee to dedicate a \$150,000 loan from the operating reserve, \$6400 from the Trustee's Fund and \$5000 from the Pass-Through Fund to be available for the Monterey County Fire Fund. Jan Vanderbilt / Betsey Pearson second. Motion carried unanimously.

Judy Guzman-Krueger reported Union Bank will be donating \$10,000 to the MC Fire Relief Fund.

# TREASURER/FINANCE COMMITTEE – Jan Vanderbilt

Jan reviewed the financial statements for June and July 2020.

Jan noted total assets through 7/31/2020 are \$293,591,516 a 10.24% increase since July 2019 and a 0.60% increase since December 2019. She highlighted grants to agencies for the month totaling \$2,323,948 were approved and recorded.

Jan noted a correction that has been made to two lines on the Operating vs Actual budget where two numbers were transposed but did not affect the overall totals.

# Motion: to approve the June 30, 2020 and July 31, 2020 financial statements as presented. Jan Vanderbilt / Abby Taylor-Silva second. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed the "Sources and Uses of Funds" document. Laurel Lee- Alexander described how the sources, regions and allocations are determined with discretionary grants and donor advised grants.

Jan reported the Finance Committee reviewed the 990 and recommends board approval.

#### Motion: to approve the 2020 990. Jan Vanderbilt / Elsa Mendoza Jimenez second. Motion carried unanimously.

Jan asked for approval of the 2020 Financial Resolution needed for the stock transfer from Janus. (Note: Date incorrect on the packet document - February 2020 will be changed to August 2020)

Motion: to approve the 2020 certified resolution to authorize that Dan Baldwin "is hereby authorized and empowered to convert, endorse, sell, assign, set over and deliver any and all shares of stock, bonds, notes or other securities standing in the name of or owned by this organization and to make, execute and deliver any and all written instruments of assignment and transfer necessary or proper to effectuate the authority hereby conferred." Jan Vanderbilt / Joe Pezzini second. Motion carried unanimously.

The budget process has started internally and will presented for review at the October board meeting and approved at the December meeting.

# **GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE – Dan Baldwin for Betsy Buchalter Adler**

The governance committee will meet to set priorities for the Fall nominating season. Next week, Dan will send out a request for nominations based on the criteria in the governance minutes. All names spark conversation and lead to something so the more names available the better the results. The committee may talk to outside agencies for recommendations.

# **INVESTMENT COMMITTEE – Giff Lehman**

Giff gave an quick overview and market value of the long-term, medium-term, and ESG portfolios.

## **COMMUNITY IMPACT INVESTMENT COMMITTEE – Nolan Kennedy**

Nolan Kennedy reported on the research and effort to fund teacher housing loans for the Monterey Peninsula Unified School District. The committee has learned that the individual housing loan business is not recommended for CFMC to get into. The committee will explore other opportunities in the Fall.

Nolan highlighted the successful impact report from the CA Farmlink and Accion Opportunity Fund loans. There is a slight delay in the start of the CA Coastal and Mission Economic Development Agency (MEDA) loans for a \$1,000,000 each, but they are moving forward. The committee has had conversations with other funders interested in participating in loaning to the underserved community based on the work CFMC has been doing.

# **RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT – Christine Dawson for Michael Reid**

Christine reviewed the monthly and annual development summary. Contributions year to date are ahead of 2019. The philanthropic services team is working hard to implement the new emergency funds and DA funds grant distribution in a fast and efficient way.

The CFMC 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary has shifted to a more digital and social media event. Amanda Holder showed one of the new video vignettes that are heartfelt stories of inspiration for the 75 year milestone of the foundation.

The committee recommends changing the name of the Resource Development Committee to Philanthropic Services Committee to align with the department title.

Motion: to approve renaming the Resource Development Committee to Philanthropic Services Committee.

Maija West / Kirk Gafill second. Motion carried unanimously.

# **GRANTS AND PROGRAMS – Ida Lopez Chan**

Ida Lopez Chan requested approval of the June1, 2020- July 31, 2020 grants.

# Motion: to approve 488 grants awarded from June 1, 2020- July 31, 2020 totaling \$3,560,075. Loren Steck / Elsa Mendoza Jimenez second. Motion carried unanimously.

# **Covid-19 Relief Fund**

Laurel reviewed the Covid-19 Relief Fund grants with over \$3.1 million donated and \$3 million granted in 127 grants. The Community Association of Big Sur (CABS) received two \$30,000 grants from CFMC that were incentive for CABS to raise more money. CABS has awarded 123 families with a total \$193,000, of which 160,000 was raised by the Big Sur community.

The board discussed how nonprofits are doing with the fires on top of Covid-19. Many nonprofit organizations are profoundly affected by the loss of fundraising events that have been canceled, reduced government funding, reduced tax revenues and reduced government services all while the demand for

services has dramatically increased. Although grantmaking from the Covid-19 Relief Fund is on a hiatus for now, there are pledges pending to begin to rebuild the fund.

# **DEI update**

The Center for Nonprofit Excellence planned workshops in 2019 around the issues of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion which began in July 2020. The interest was very strong with 49 participants from 15 organizations. CFMC has an internal DEI book club and is keeping the issues in the forefront of values for the organization.

# Monterey Fire Relief Fund (MCRF)

The community responded quickly and generously to Monterey County Fire Relief Fund. Over \$200,000 was raised in the first week. The Center for Nonprofit Excellence immediately set up a resource page for with important information. CFMC responded within days with four emergency grants to vetted agencies that will provide support to residents in their areas: These grants did not require an application.

# **NEW FUNDS – Dan Baldwin**

Dan noted the Juneteenth Fund is not moving forward at this time, but CFMC is discussing revisiting the fund in the future. Dan highlighted the positive outcome from the Monterey County Tolerance and Acceptance Fund that was established by board member Erica Padilla-Chavez after a difficult situation affected her family and neighborhood. Although current events are very distracting, Dan remembered former Salinas Mayor Joe Gunter and the legacy he leaves with the *Mayor Joe Gunter Memorial Fund for the Veterans Day Parade.*

# **Board of Equalization update**

In 2019, CFMC filed a claim for a tax-exempt status for reduced taxes on the 3200/3400 17 Mile Drive property in Pebble Beach. Recently, the Board of Equalization sent an opinion letter and the MC Board of Supervisors denied the claim. CFMC legal counsel feels an appeal is not in the best interest of CFMC to pursue further and recommends withdrawing the claim from the County Supervisors agenda. **After a thorough discussion, the board reached consensus to take the advice of CFMC legal counsel to withdraw the claim.** 

# Juneteenth Fund update

Birt discussed the topic of "systems change" as a starting point for a new fund. Dan believes CFMC is the organization to act as a compass point and stand behind the values of systemic change. Dan and Birt convened a meeting with leaders of color in the county to begin a conversation about "what is a starting point?" Education came up as a place that is fundamental to a person's life path. The economic disparity of the cost per student invested in schools throughout the County could be an impactful source for additional funding. A second meeting with members of the board and community leaders will take place to build on the ideas for investment in long term change.

The meeting of the Finance Committee of the Community Foundation for Monterey County was called to order by Jan Vanderbilt at 2:00PM on August 25, 2020. The meeting was conducted via Zoom.

## 2019 Form 990

Kim Said presented the 2019 Form 990.

David Warner questioned the amount in box G, Gross receipts, and asked what the difference is between gross receipts and total revenue. Kim explained what is included in the gross receipts amount.

Joe Pezzini asked for clarification on what is considered public support. Kim explained that the amount refers to contributions, and not any revenue from investments, or any revenue from sources not related to the mission of the CFMC.

On a motion by Birt Johnson, Jr., seconded by Jan Vanderbilt, the committee approved moving the Form 990 forward to the full board for acceptance.

# **Minutes**

On a motion by Joe Pezzini, seconded by Birt Johnson, Jr., the June 23, 2020 minutes were approved.

#### **Financial Statement Review**

Jan led a discussion on the June and July 2020 financial statements. Joe questioned the variances for Services and D & O Insurance. Diane Nonella identified that it was a transposition in the budget column between the two lines and will correct the numbers before the board meeting.

On a motion by Joe Pezzini, seconded by Teri Belli, the committee approved the June 2020 and July 2020 financial statements, with the corrections to the budget amounts to Services and D & O Insurance.

# **Discussion Items**

Dan reviewed the two open positions, the Director of Development and Director of the CNE, and the plan for filling the positions.

Dan and Diane reviewed the budget process, status, and timeline.

Dan explained the plan for moving forward with finding a replacement for FIMS.

Dan reviewed his idea to take up to \$150,000 from the operating reserve, as necessary, for the Monterey County Fire Relief Fund, plus \$6,400 from the Trusteed Fund and \$5,000 from the Pass-Thru Fund.

The committee had a full discussion about the recommendation and at the conclusion, on a motion by Jan Vanderbilt, seconded by Birt Johnson, Jr., the committee approved moving the recommendation to take \$150,000 from the operating reserve, \$6,400 from the Trustees Fund and \$5,000 from the Pass-Thru Fund forward to the full board for approval.

Dan informed the committee that we have implemented phone reimbursements for staff, for the additional use of their cell phones while working from home, Dan also informed the committee that we will be looking at potential year-end bonuses, also to help cover some of the added costs due to working from home.

Dan informed the committee of Phil's retirement and the plan to fill the position.

# CALL TO ORDER – Birt Johnson, Jr.

Birt Johnson called the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Community Foundation for Monterey County to order at 3:32 on September 22, 2020.

# **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

# Motion: to approve the July 22, 2020 minutes as written. Teri Belli / Betsy Buchalter Adler second. Motion carried unanimously.

# **REPORT OF THE CHAIR – Birt Johnson, Jr.**

Birt recognized the stress in the community from the impact of the fires throughout the Central Coast. The loss of homes and poor air quality has seriously affected the state of California. Birt called attention to the CFMC staff and board for acting quickly to get grants out the door.

The past chair's luncheon was held via Zoom on September 2. There were 14 CFMC past chairs in attendance. Birt provided a welcome and Dan reviewed the highlights of the year, revisions to the strategic plan and response to the recent disasters. The 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary PowerPoint shared the voices of many past chairs highlighting their memories of the work CFMC has done over the years.

The Executive Committee agreed to keep the November 24<sup>th</sup> meeting as planned.

# TREASURERS REPORT- Jan Vanderbilt

Jan Vanderbilt reported the August financial statement will be approved at the October finance committee meeting. She highlighted the total assets through August 31, 2020 were \$301,558,829, a 13.2% increase since August 2019. The expendable operating cash-on-hand is at 5.2 months which includes the PPP. The actual net operating deficit is \$451,872 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$704,968.

# PHILANTHROPIC SERVICES COMMITTEE - Michael Reid

Michael Reid acknowledged the CFMC organization for the pivot and nimble responses the team made during the pandemic and fires in 2020.

Christine Dawson reported the new position of Director of Philanthropy has been posted.

CFMC's Center for Non-Profit Excellence is collaborating with AFP, on a Zoom presentation titled *Demystifying Donor Advised Funds,* led by Christine Dawson and Dan Baldwin.

The launch of the 2020 Monterey County Gives Campaign will be September 25 for challenge gifts and November 12 for general donations.

The 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary video stories and vignettes are active in different venues throughout local media and on our website.

# COMMUNITY IMPACT COMMITTEE – Ida Lopez Chan

Ida Chan noted the CI staff has not missed a beat in making grants during the pandemic, working remotely and during the fire emergencies.

# **Covid-19 Relief Fund Grants Update**

Laurel Lee-Alexander updated the board on the Covid-19 Relief Fund grantmaking. Approximately, \$3.2 million has been raised and over \$3 million has been grated for essential services, basic needs and the most vulnerable. The fund was temporarily closed to rebuild the balance. The CV-19 Relief Fund grantmaking was re-opened on September 18 and new applications are being reviewed.

# Monterey County Fire Relief Fund (MCFR)

The MCFR has raised close to \$1 million and is working with affiliate funds in Carmel Valley and Big Sur to distribute grants to those most affected by the fires. CFMC team is being very proactive and working quickly by waiving the need for grant applications is some cases.

# **CI Grant Program**

Laurel reported the CI team is gearing up for the Fall Community Impact grant season.

# **INVESTMENT COMMITTEE – Giff Lehman**

Giff reported a 2.7% positive return in the investment pool since the August board meeting. He will have a full update at the October board meeting.

# COMMUNITY IMPACT INVESTING – Dan Baldwin for Nolan Kennedy

Dan reported the on the September 15 meeting. There was discussion about a possible vendor to handle some of the administration of impact investments. The committee is considering Community Capital Advisors, experts in this field with analytics reporting as their specialty.

The committee is looking at "where do we go from here?" Based on what they have learned in the last 18 months, Dan and Nolan are researching the areas of nonprofit loan funds, affordable housing and having discussions with community leaders.

# **GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE – Betsy Buchalter Adler**

Betsy Buchalter Adler reported on the September 14 meeting which focused on the priorities outlined for nominating 2021 board members. Betsy presented a list of eight candidates qualified in the areas of estate planning attorney, philanthropic resources, the Seaside community, generational diversity

and emerging new leaders. Betsy will report at the October board meeting, after which the committee will begin reaching out to the candidates.

Betsy presented a proposed slate of officers that will be put in front of the board at the October meeting.

# **NEW FUND APPROVALS – Dan Baldwin**

Dan described a couple of the new funds for August. The Pfeiffer Ridge Fund is set up to make a grant the Community Association of Big Sur (CABS) to purchase the home of artist Emile Norman in Big Sur. The funds will be used to retain the house and carry out the donor's intent for charitable activity in Big Sur.

The Weston Call Fund of Big Sur was formed as an affiliate fund, which was an awkward classification for the fund. The Call's and CFMC decided to reclassify the fund to a Special Purpose fund. This does not require a vote.

# **PRESIDENT/CEO REPORT - Dan Baldwin**

# • Staffing report

Dan has been having one on one conversations with staff members to check in on their remote work and home experience during the pandemic. Michael Reid asked about whether there were any financial hardships reported by the staff from the Covid-19 shutdown. Dan discussed communicating openly to the staff about the foreseeable future and his confidence in the financial stability of CFMC at this point.

There are three open positions. The Director for the CNE is filled by Susie Polnaszek who has been named acting director. She is working closely with Laurel Lee- Alexander on the direction, goals and function of CNE going forward. The position will not be filled until a clearer direction for the CNE is determined.

The other two openings are Accounting Manager, and a Director of Development, a new position. CFMC is receiving and reviewing applications.

# • Legislative update

AB 2936 was not heard by the Senate Appropriations Committee so is no longer and active bill. Dan is working with a team of California community foundation CEO's to proactively write a values statement to describe how Donor Advised Funds (DAF'S) are utilized. The Community Foundation Public Awareness Initiative has been formed to educate the legislature staff on community foundation's donor advised funds process and positive results.

# Community Impact Investment Committee Minutes September 15, 2020

# <u>Assets</u>

Total Assets through 8/31/2020 are \$301,558,829 a 13.12% increase since August 2019 and a 3.33% increase since December 2019.

## Charitable Remainder Trusts (CRT) and Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

The CRT and CGA funds have been adjusted to reflect the activity and balances per Kaspick & Company and the third-party account balances as of December 31, 2019. In August, Robert Haas establish his 9<sup>th</sup> CGA with \$60,000 cash, the calculated remainder value is \$22,829, for the Operating Fund.

## **Realized and Unrealized Gains and Losses on Investments**

Net year-to-date realized losses were \$5,560,813, and unrealized gains were \$12,420,388, for a total gain of \$6,859,575.

# **Operating Fund**

Total revenue was \$53,535 more than the budget, and total expenses were \$160,448 less than the budget. Realized and unrealized gains were \$39,336 on the operating reserve held in the Medium-Term Fund portfolio. The actual net operating deficit is \$451,872 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$704,968.

**Note:** The Expendable Operating Cash-on-Hand is at 5.2 months, excluding the operating reserve of \$500,000, the building reserve of \$150,000, and including the PPP Loan of \$411,402, which is expected to be forgiven.

# Portfolio Performance

The market value of the Long-Term Fund portfolio at 8/31/2020 was \$247,506,368. The one-year Total Return for the Long-Term Endowment Portfolio was 9.8% compared to the Policy Index of 10.4%.

The market value of the Medium-Term Fund portfolio at 8/31/2020 was \$7,697,501. The one-year Total Return for the Medium-Term Endowment Portfolio was 11.3% compared to the Policy Index of 9.7%.

The market value of the ESG Fund portfolio at 8/31/2020 was \$3,936,847. The one-year Total Return for the ESG Portfolio was 11.0% compared to the Policy Index of 12.0%.

The market value of the DRIM Fund portfolio at 8/31/2020 was \$2,487,824. The one-year Total Return for the DRIM Portfolio was 7.6% compared to the Policy Index of -15.9%. Due to the timing of the DRIM reports, there is a one-month lag in the performance reporting.

# **Special Program Funds**

Special Program Funds include: Pathways to Safety, funded by the ACTION Council of Monterey County; the Center for Nonprofit Excellence funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; the College Futures Foundation program, funded by the College Futures Foundation; the Salinas Leadership project, funded by the James Irvine Foundation; the Census 2020 project funded by the State of California, through the Ventura County Community Foundation; and the Monterey County Gives annual campaign.

Total Special Program revenue was \$498,133 and total expenses were \$6,124,355, which includes \$5,256,448 in grants from the 2019 Monterey County Gives campaign.

# <u>Assets</u>

Total Assets through 9/30/2020 are \$296,532,135 a 9.68% increase since September 2019 and a 1.61% increase since December 2019.

#### Charitable Remainder Trusts (CRT) and Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

The CRT and CGA funds have been adjusted to reflect the activity and balances per Kaspick & Company and the third-party account balances as of December 31, 2019.

#### **Realized and Unrealized Gains and Losses on Investments**

Net year-to-date realized losses were \$5,519,431, and unrealized gains were \$6,077,603, for a total gain of \$558,172.

## **Operating Fund**

Total revenue was \$16,416 more than the budget, and total expenses were \$219,239 less than the budget. Realized and unrealized gains were \$30,740 on the operating reserve held in the Medium-Term Fund portfolio. The actual net operating surplus is \$56,838 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$209,306.

**Note:** The Expendable Operating Cash-on-Hand is at 5.2 months, excluding the operating reserve of \$500,000, the building reserve of \$150,000, and including the PPP Loan of \$411,402, which is expected to be forgiven.

#### Portfolio Performance

The market value of the Long-Term Fund portfolio at 9/30/2020 was \$239,690,495. The one-year Total Return for the Long-Term Endowment Portfolio was 6.3% compared to the Policy Index of 6.8%.

The market value of the Medium-Term Fund portfolio at 9/30/2020 was \$7,625,071. The one-year Total Return for the Medium-Term Endowment Portfolio was 9.6% compared to the Policy Index of 8.0%.

The market value of the ESG Fund portfolio at 9/30/2020 was \$3,999,775. The one-year Total Return for the ESG Portfolio was 7.9% compared to the Policy Index of 8.6%.

The market value of the DRIM Fund portfolio at 9/30/2020 was \$2,513,735. The one-year Total Return for the DRIM Portfolio was 12.0% compared to the Policy Index of -6.1%. Due to the timing of the DRIM reports, there is a one-month lag in the performance reporting.

# **Special Program Funds**

Special Program Funds include: Pathways to Safety, funded by the ACTION Council of Monterey County; the Center for Nonprofit Excellence funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; the College Futures Foundation program, funded by the College Futures Foundation; the Salinas Leadership project, funded by the James Irvine Foundation; the Census 2020 project funded by the State of California, through the Ventura County Community Foundation; and the Monterey County Gives annual campaign.

Total Special Program revenue was \$559,262 and total expenses were \$6,132,213, which includes \$5,256,448 in grants from the 2019 Monterey County Gives campaign.




