### COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR MONTEREY COUNTY NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the Five Months Ended May 31, 2021

#### **Assets**

Total Assets through 5/31/2021 are \$365,472,698 a 30.21% increase since May 2020 and a 4.91% increase since December 2020. (p. 3)

### Charitable Remainder Trusts (CRT) and Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

The CRT and CGA funds have been adjusted to reflect the activity and balances per Kaspick & Company and the third-party account balances as of December 31, 2021. In May, Stephen and Barbara Brooks added \$99,581 to their CRT, with a calculated remainder value of \$52,622. (p. 5)

#### Realized and Unrealized Gains and Losses on Investments

Net year-to-date realized gains were \$2,213, and unrealized gains were \$22,893,122, for a total gain of \$22,895,335. (p. 6)

#### **Operating Fund**

Total revenue was \$866,783 more than the budget, and total expenses were \$68,797 less than the budget. Unrealized gains were \$14,171 on the operating reserve held in the Medium-Term Fund portfolio. The actual net operating surplus is \$346,516 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$603,086. (p. 7)

**Note:** The Expendable Operating Cash-on-Hand is at 10.8 months, excluding the operating reserve of \$500,000, the building reserve of \$150,000, and includes the PPP Loan, which was fully forgiven March 31, 2021. (p. 8)

### **Portfolio Performance**

The market value of the Long-Term Fund portfolio at 5/31/2021 was \$305,044,727. The one-year Total Return for the Long-Term Endowment Portfolio was 29.9% compared to the Policy Index of 26.4%. (p. 9-11)

The market value of the Medium-Term Fund portfolio at 5/31/2021 was \$9,124,754. The one-year Total Return for the Medium-Term Endowment Portfolio was 16.0% compared to the Policy Index of 13.8%. (p. 12-13)

The market value of the ESG Fund portfolio at 5/31/2021 was \$4,938,903. The one-year Total Return for the ESG Portfolio was 23.3% compared to the Policy Index of 23.5%. **(p. 14-15)** 

The market value of the DRIM Fund portfolio at 5/31/2021 was \$2,632,158. The one-year Total Return for the DRIM Portfolio was 46.3% compared to the Policy Index of 79.0%. Due to the timing of the DRIM reports, there is a one-month lag in the performance reporting. (p. 16-17)

### **Special Program Funds**

Special Program Funds include: Center for Nonprofit Excellence funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; the College Futures Foundation program, funded by the College Futures Foundation; the Salinas Leadership project, funded by the James Irvine Foundation; and the Monterey County Gives annual campaign.


